Sing a Song

The Light the World Giving Machine "One Drop" video helps children see that the items in the machine are real and helping people.

Say a Prayer:

As we explain prayer to our children, we may include (1) expressing gratitude, (2) pleading for unity and love, (3) asking for help in time of need, and (4) seeking strength to resist or overcome. Gratitude. Through prayer we can express our gratitude to our Father in Heaven for his kindness and blessings.

VENDING vs. GIVING MACHINE

Discussion:

- Have you ever bought treats from a vending machine?
- What did you buy from a vending machine?
- How much did it cost?
- Who paid for it?

A Giving Machine works much like a vending machine. There are items you can buy, and you use money to buy them. The difference is that instead of buying a treat for yourself, you are buying something for someone in need. Lets find out what kind of things people need.

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GIVING MACHINE SAVINGS JAR

Find a jar or container in your house that you can use to collect money. In the weeks leading up to when your family will visit the Giving Machine, see how full you can fill the jar with money. Make it fun by decorating it and/or taping pictures of the item(s) you would like to save for onto the jar.

*Please note that the Giving Machine only accepts credit cards. This activity is to help children understand the physical nature of money.

What are some ways of adding money to the jar?

- Ask family or friends for some extra jobs to earn money.
- When you purchase something at a store, put the change into the jar.
- Find some coins around your home? Put them in the jar.
- With permission from your parents, hold a bake sale or lemonade stand to earn money to put in the jar.
- Instead of going out to eat or buying a treat one day, put the money you would have spent into the jar.

Essentials Checklist (For Young Family Members)

Essentials are the basic items that we need to be healthy and happy. In this activity, family members will learn about essential items available in the Giving Machine in an active way.



Do 10 jumping jacks if you have toys.

Spin around 5 times if you help your family clean the house.



Touch your toes 6 times if you sleep in a warm home.

Jump up and down 7 times if you own a pair of shoes.



Clap your hands 8 times if you like ducks.

Can you find any cleaning tools in your house?

Read Deuteronomy 15:7,11
